

Pets Helping People Job Description for Volunteer Training Staff

Pets Helping People (PHP) is seeking additional training support (2-3 trainers) for our pet therapy (Animal Assisted Interactions) training program. This is a part-time (approximately 2.5 - 6 hours per month) volunteer position that makes an important contribution to pet therapy services, serving people in need of comfort and support in our community. This is an opportunity to expand your network of clients, establish or enhance your brand as a top trainer in the area.

PHP is a local nonprofit founded in 1998 on the premise that a dog's unconditional love, when paired with compassionate humans, is a remarkable source of community support and comfort. PHP's mission is to improve the lives of the vulnerable and others through animal-assisted (pet therapy) interactions. Services include: training and accreditation, collaborations, education and awareness, Waggin' Tails (a therapy performance troupe) and Comfort Paws (stress relief visits and public events). PHP provides services in the metro Milwaukee and four county areas. This is not "service dog" training.

Where: Our classes are held at Congregational Home located at 13900 W Burleigh Rd in Brookfield...easy access

off of Hwy 41/45.

When: An Assessment is the first step. Assessments are held before the 2nd week of class at 6pm.

After the teams pass, they sign up for a 4-week pet therapy training program.

1st week is Orientation without the dogs. Class is conducted by other team members

2nd week is Assessment at 6pm and Training Class at 7pm concludes at 8:30pm (2.5 hours)

• 3rd week is Training Class at 7pm and concludes at 8:30pm (1.5 hours)

4th week is Test Night at 7pm and concludes at 8:30pm (1.5 hours)

Qualities and capabilities:

The qualified applicant would have experience with obedience training in a group setting and be well versed in canine body language and behavior. Candidate will also follow "Positive/Force Free" Reinforcement and be comfortable with leading and/or co-leading the class with other trainers. Good interpersonal communication skills.
